New DeSoto Bass stop will be added to senior bus route

Starting on Friday, February 23, the RTA will be adding a new stop to Senior Route 64 AB, which runs on Fridays. The route has stops at Westown Shopping Center, Walmart, Meijer, and Kroger. This route only runs on Fridays.

Riders are able to exit the route at any stop, but they get on at specific stops that serve seniors. While anyone can ride, please be respectful of seniors for whom it is intended.
